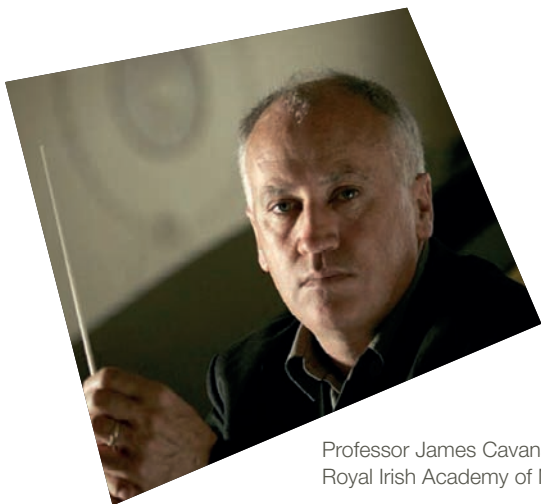
Music Generation Sligo Masterclass & Performance Programme @ The Model, Sligo

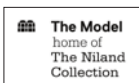
