This is an opportunity for young string players to develop ensemble playing within the classical genre, engaging with high level artists in the nurturing environment of the Festival. The weekend also brings young musicians into the audience to experience live performances of an international standard at one of Ireland's leading chamber music events.

Masterclasses will be led by members of the Vogler Quartet and other festival performers. Ensemble activities will be directed by Professor James Cavanagh, curator. We invite string players, age 13+, grade 5 or above.
